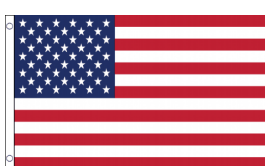
And no country quiz would be complete without flags so here are 3 that start with "U" and 1 that starts with "A" – U3A geddit? 😊
