Call for Nominations for the Executive Committee

The Executive Committee is elected at each AGM as existing members must stand down.

Nominations may be submitted using one of two methods: either by completing the following form or by email.

Officers and members of the Executive Committee are elected for one year with an entitlement to stand for re-election subject to the Terms of Office laid down in the Constitution. The Committee has a minimum of 6 and maximum of 15 members.

Positions will be decided by secret on-line ballot held during September.

Mandatory officers – Chair, Secretary, Treasurer

Non- mandatory officers: up to two Vice- Chairs and ordinary members 3 - 12 posts.

Any BaM u3a member may be nominated for any of the above positions. Proposers and seconders must be BaM u3a members **but who are not current Committee members**.

The current committee is listed on the **Committee and Contact** page of the website and would be delighted to discuss the workings of the committee with anybody who is interested in joining.

Email method:

The nominated person should send an email statement of their intention, and office to which they wish to stand (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Member), with names of proposer and seconder.
