

The Summer School at Chichester University

is run by the South East U3A Forum for all members.

CHOICE OF COURSES

Please indicate which course will be your 1st choice, with a 2nd or 3rd choice if you are prepared to join them. If your 1st choice is full, when your application is received you will be assigned to your 2nd or 3rd choice. All applications are processed in order of receipt. There is no opportunity to mix courses. Some courses may have to be cancelled if there are insufficient numbers, or a Tutor is not available on the day, we will then offer you a place on another course. School starts on Monday from 3pm and closes after lunch on Thursday.

CHOICE OF ACCOMMODATION

All accommodation is in SINGLE standard or en-suite rooms in blocks a few minutes level walk to the self service restaurant and teaching block. Buildings may be up to 3 storeys, **SOME** with lifts, there is a kitchen with tea and coffee making facilities on each floor. Towels and linen are provided and there are hairdryers and hangers available from Reception. Standard rooms have a washbasin and rooms are in groups of 6 sharing a bathroom, shower and toilet facilities, but they do not have lifts and are NOT recommended for members with significant disabilities.
