

Waddesdon Walk Tuesday, 11th April 2017

On a sunny morning ten of us started our circular walk at Waddesdon from the car park of The Lion public house. Passing the Five Arrows Hotel we turned down Silk Street entering the grounds of Waddesdon Manor.

Keeping to the bridleway we made our way towards Windmill Hill Farm. En route and whilst admiring the views, we crossed the Millenium Avenue of 2000 trees linking the Manor with Upper Winchendon. At Windmill Hill Farm we passed the award winning Waddesdon Archive building and spectacular views across the valley.



Continuing on the bridleway for about a mile, we turned up towards the Manor via a footpath across ancient ridge & furrow fields. On reaching the Manor grounds we headed back towards Silk Street and on to The Lion where nine of us enjoyed a pleasant lunch.
