3. Chair & Officers Reports

I have been involved with the committee as a trustee for 2 years now, and what a 2 years it has been! Covid struck and everything stopped, we had no easy means of contacting members so opted to join the u3a-wide **Beacon** system which holds all members details. Collating accurate information was a huge task for **Gillian**, our membership secretary, but I am happy to say the system is working well. Another real benefit of Beacon is that members can **view and update their own details**. As yet we have not explored further the use of Beacon for groups and finance, but that is an option for the future.

As another way of staying in contact to complement the **Web site** we introduced a private **FaceBook group** which many of our members are enjoying.

During lockdown, **Group leaders** kept in touch with group members, including **Adam's Podcasts** – he never dreamed there would be so many of them. Eventually outside groups, like photography and walking began to meet again and enjoy each others company. In September we took our first tentative steps towards group meeting, wearing masks and braving icy blasts of fresh air. We have enjoyed talks from the uses of needles to the comedy of Laurel and Hardy, and more varied talks are planned.

As confidence grew in the vaccination programme, indoor groups began to meet and I am pleased to say that we have 4 new groups running Flower arranging, Line dancing, Art Appreciation and Exploring Technology alongside Art, Bridge, Contemporary Music, Rail Enthusiasts and Scrabble.

Any new idea for a group would be welcome, and don't think that you would be totally responsible, the committee will help you get it off the ground and you can share the work with a friend... You may think that this will take you out of your comfort zone, but u3a is about **LEARNING for enjoyment...** and there is plenty of help available.

We want to give a heartfelt thanks to **ALL** our group leaders, including Ann Small, Kath Robinson and Brenda Fairfull who had to give up their groups – without you the u3a could not exist. I also want to thank **Kath Lodge** who organises trips which many of us enjoy. Finally I would like to mention our retiring Treasurer, **Peter Winfield**, who is now Exploring Technology, **Denise Walter**, our retiring Business Secretary and **Kay Blyth**, retired as Speaker secretary, as well as **Stephanie Yearnshire** who was forced to step down as chairman but is still there for advice when needed

5. Approval of examined accounts Peter Winfield Treasurer reported

The charge for membership renewal was suspended for 2021/22, with 24 new members paying £240. but the u3a Trust required a capitation fee of £595, and the Beacon membership management system charged £216.

The groups continued where they could and with a little support of £60 they are now hoping to be self-funded and Kath Lodge has started trips which have been well supported. The monthly meeting at £2 a head less speaker and room rent achieved a small surplus. The lack of income from the subs meant the year ended with a deficit of just over £1000, leaving us with total funds in the bank of £9442, which includes £1866 in subscriptions for 2022/23. This gives us a solid base with which to continue.
