RENEWAL OF YOUR MEMBERSHIP

Our new membership year commences on 1st October 2023. You should have received either an email or a letter inviting you to renew.

Online renewal

This is the easiest way for both you and us. Please Log In to our Beacon system using the link on the right hand side and then follow the link for renewals. Joint members may include both subscriptions in a single payment.

1. If you wish to change your membership type (for instance by adding or deleting your TAM magazine subscription) then please email us beforehand to amend this. Unfortunately you are not able to change this yourself.

On the Beacon Homescreen (shown below) enter your **Email** address and **Password** and then select **Confirm Identity**. Note, if you have not registered a Password then select **Register for a membership account**. This will then send you an email containing a link which then takes you to a Beacon screen prompting you to enter your details such as **U3A Membership Number, Email Address, Postal Address** including **Post Code** and you can select your Password. When completed, you will then be returned to the screen shown below where you can log into the system to renew your membership subscription.

Gift Aid

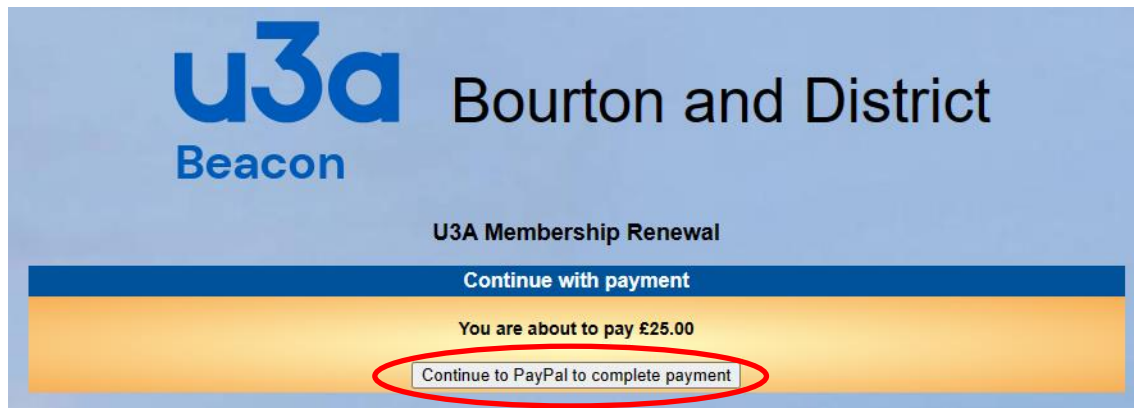

After payment, you should receive an e-mail from PayPal as well as an e-mail from Bourton and District U3A to confirm renewal

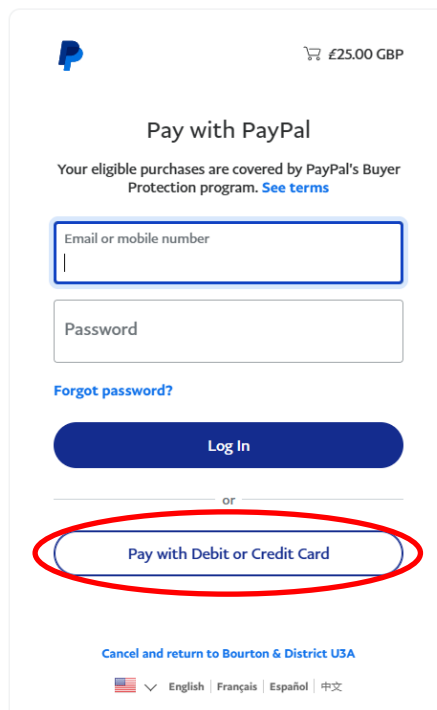

When you have selected **Make Payment** you will see a summary page of what you are about to pay and a button to take you to PayPal to make the payment. You do **not** need a PayPal account.



The following shows how to make the required payment using the PayPal system as a **Guest** (i.e. without having a PayPal account).

Select **Pay with Debit or Credit Card**.



You will then be taken to a screen where you need to enter all your particular details including **Billing Address** and **Card details**, see below. Note, ensure **Country** is set to **UK** as the default setting is for United States as shown.




Payment confirmation shown below.

Click on **Return to Seller** to return back to our U3A Beacon system Homescreen which will now have been updated to reflect your membership continuation.


