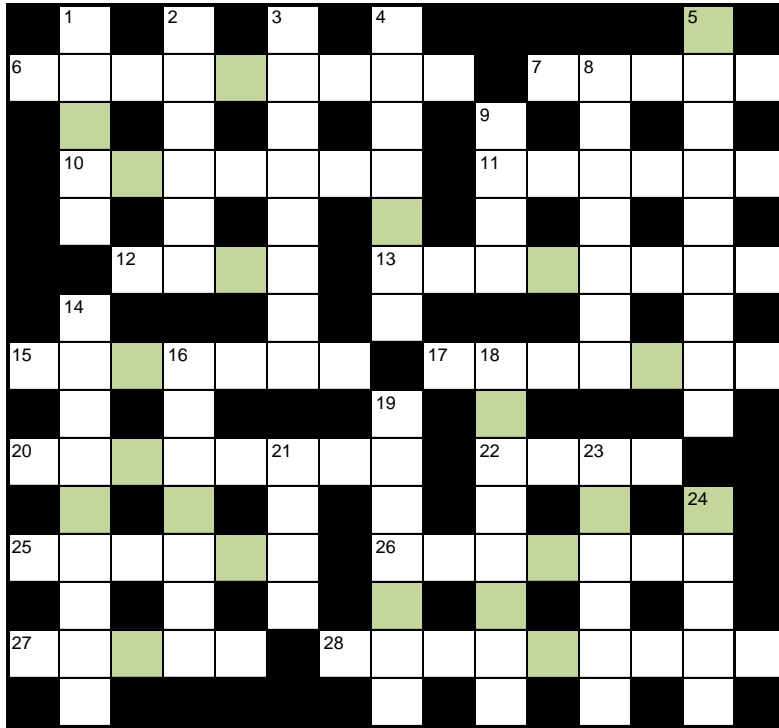


Branston U3A Crossword19 – and Polyword
