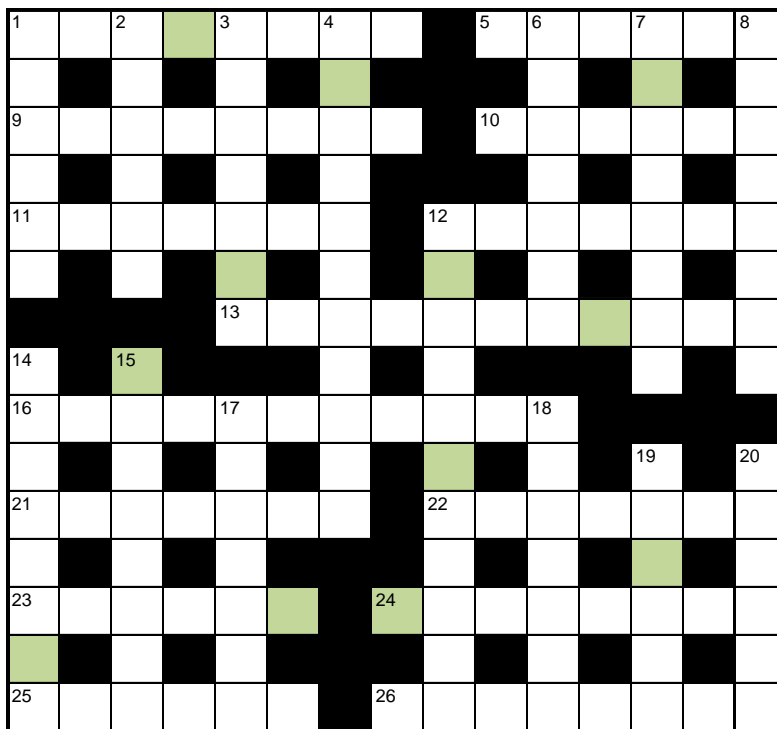


Branston U3A Crossword20 – and Polyword
