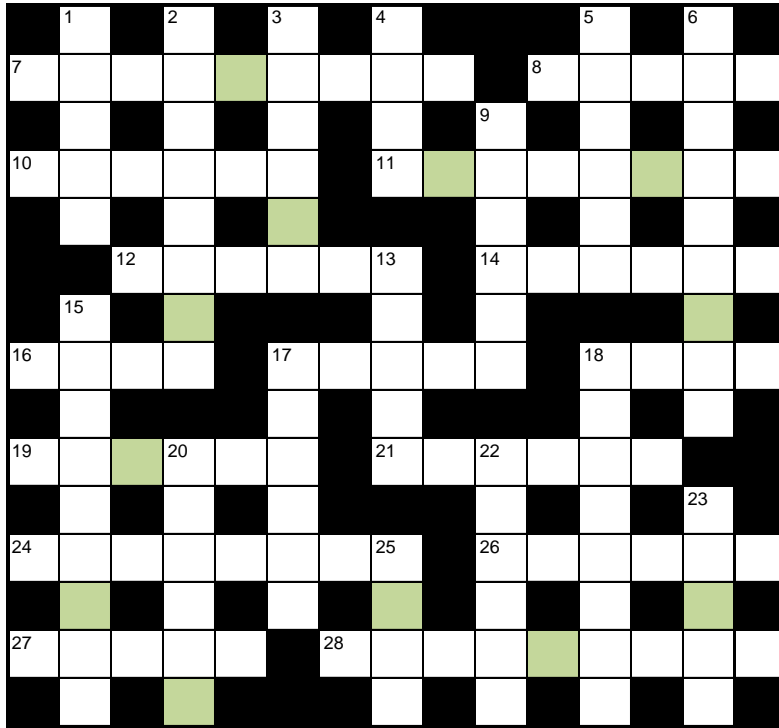


Branston U3A Crossword 21 – and Polyword
