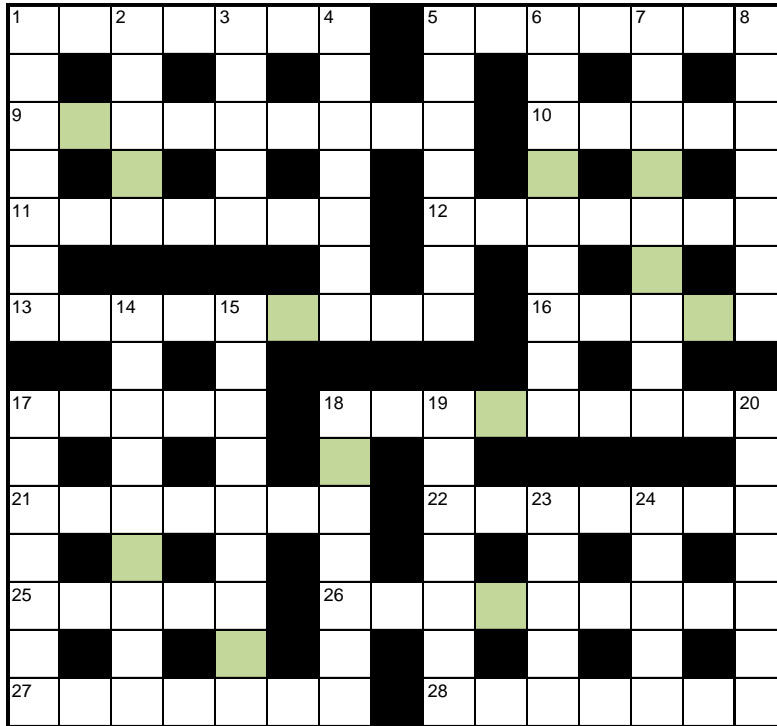


Branston U3A Crossword 22 – and Polyword
