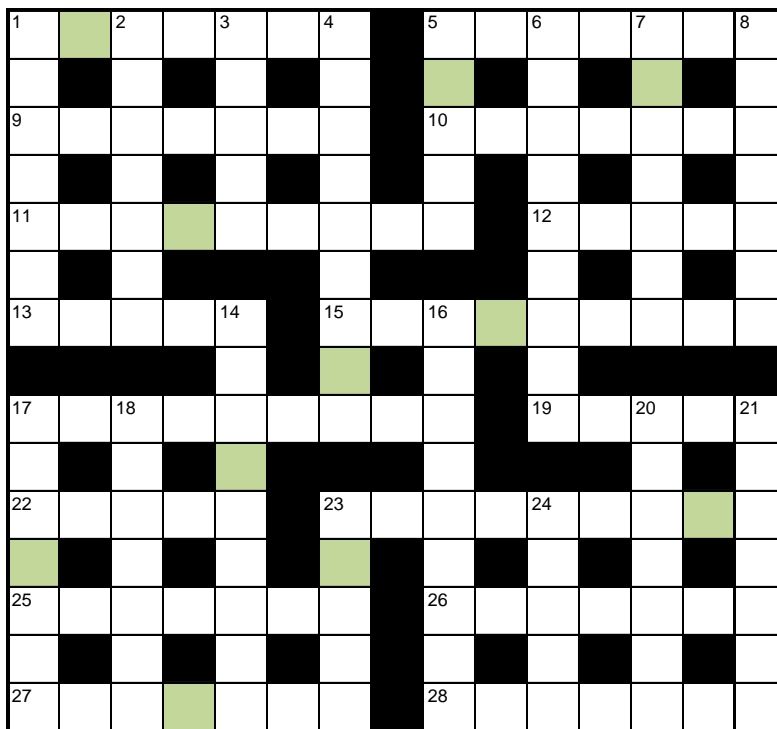


Branston U3A Crossword 23 – and Polyword
