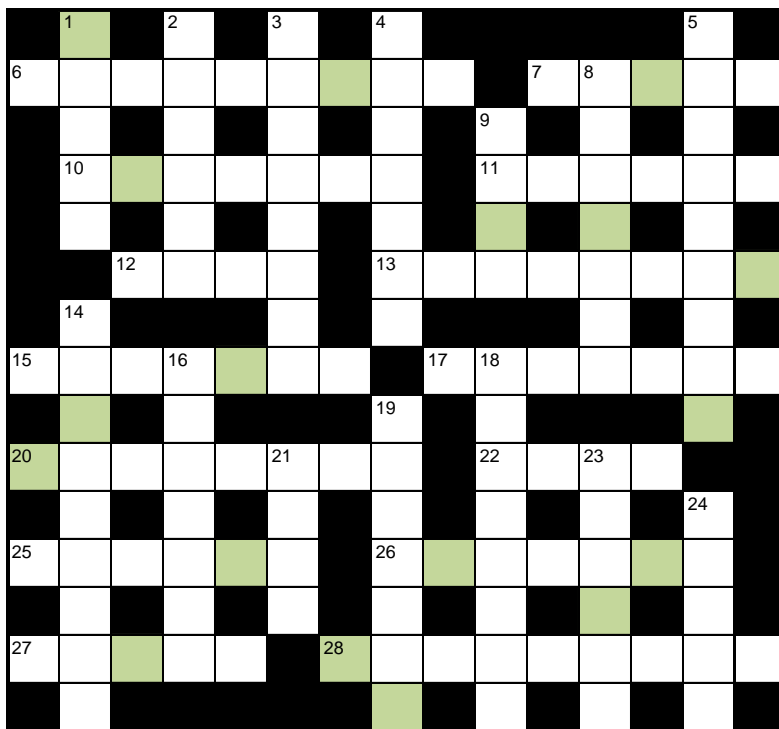


Branston U3A Crossword 24 – and Polyword
