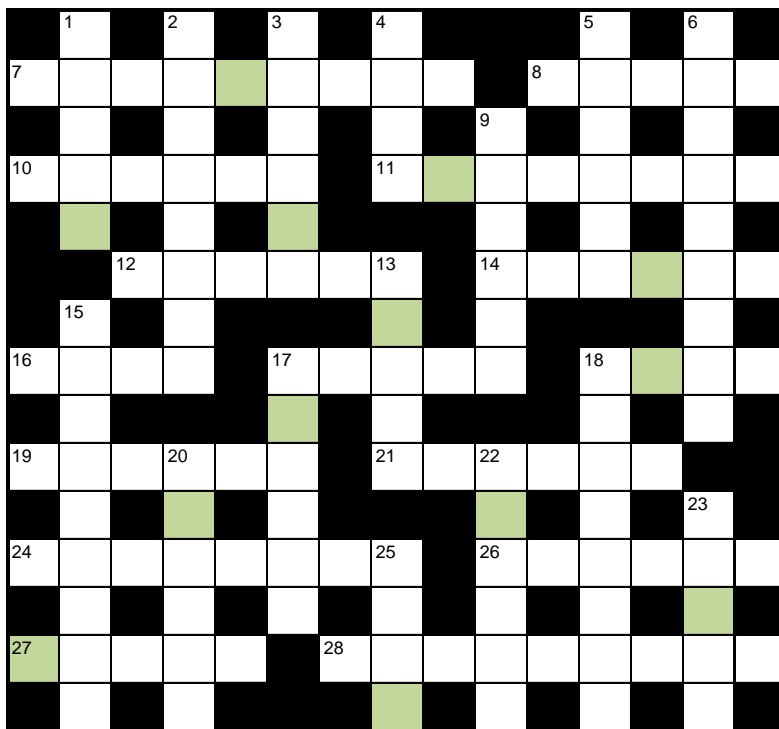


## Branston U3A Crossword 27 – and Polyword
