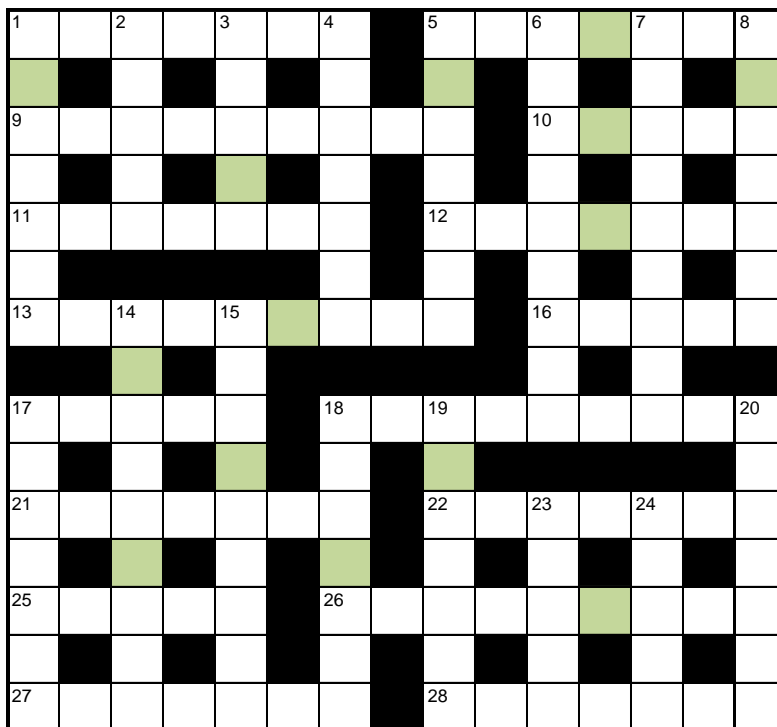


Branston U3A Crossword 28 – and Polyword
