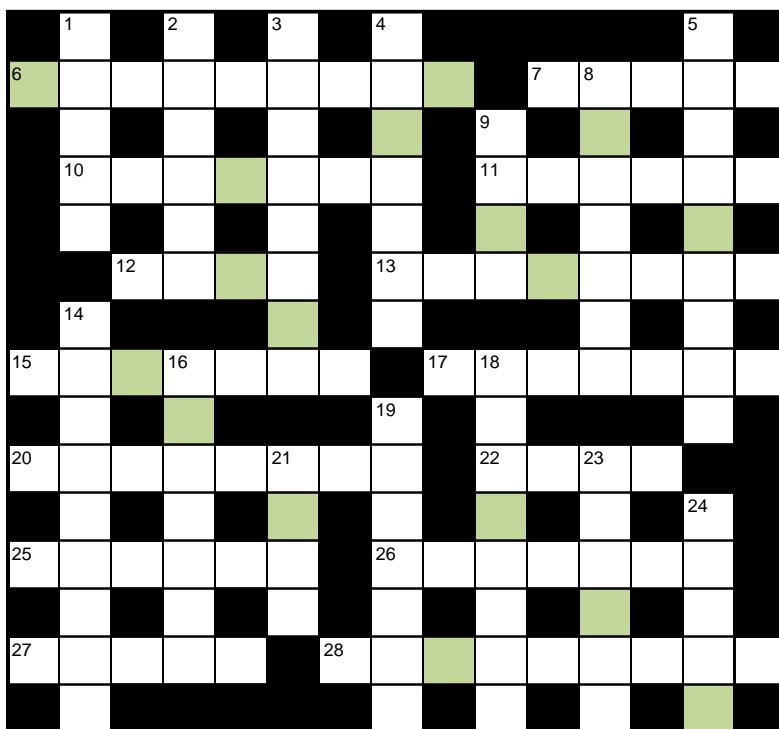


## Branston U3A Crossword 30 – and Polyword
