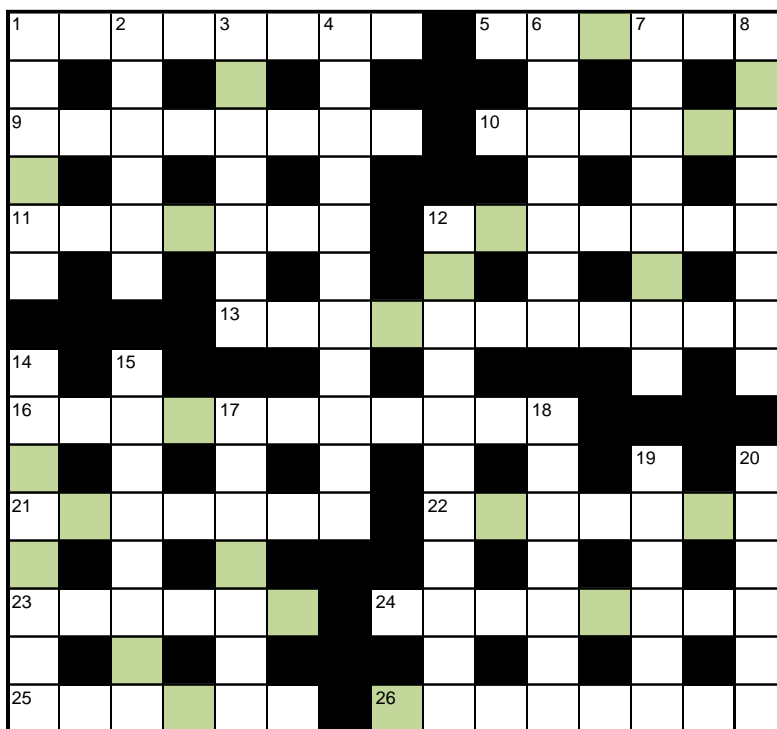


## Branston U3A Crossword 31 – and Polyword
