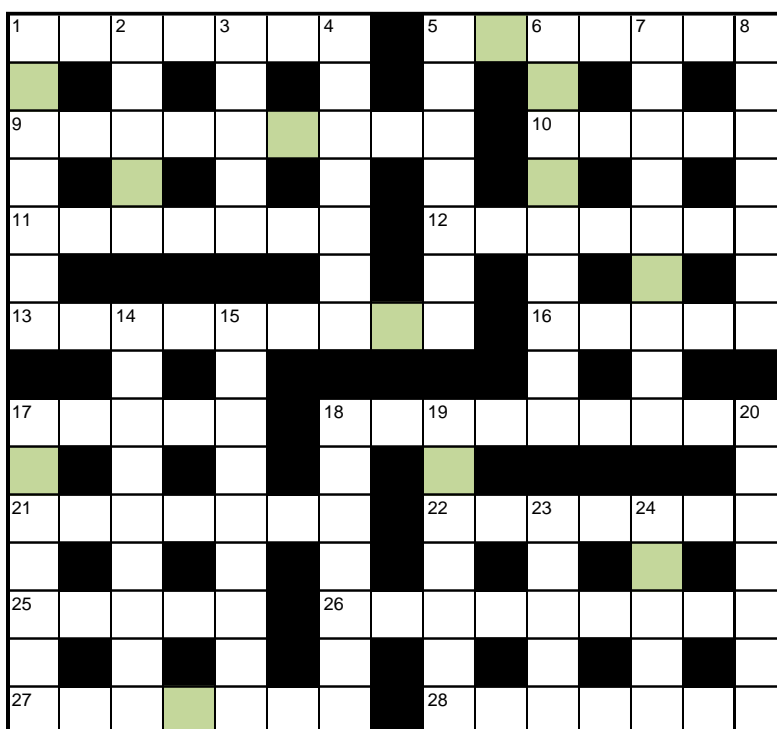


## Branston U3A Crossword 33 – and Polyword
