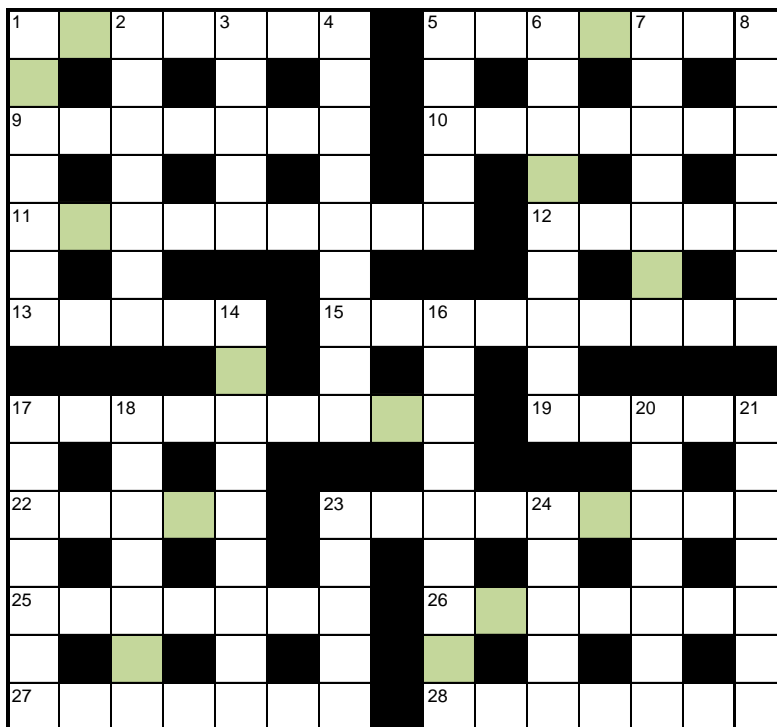


Branston U3A Crossword 34 – and Polyword
