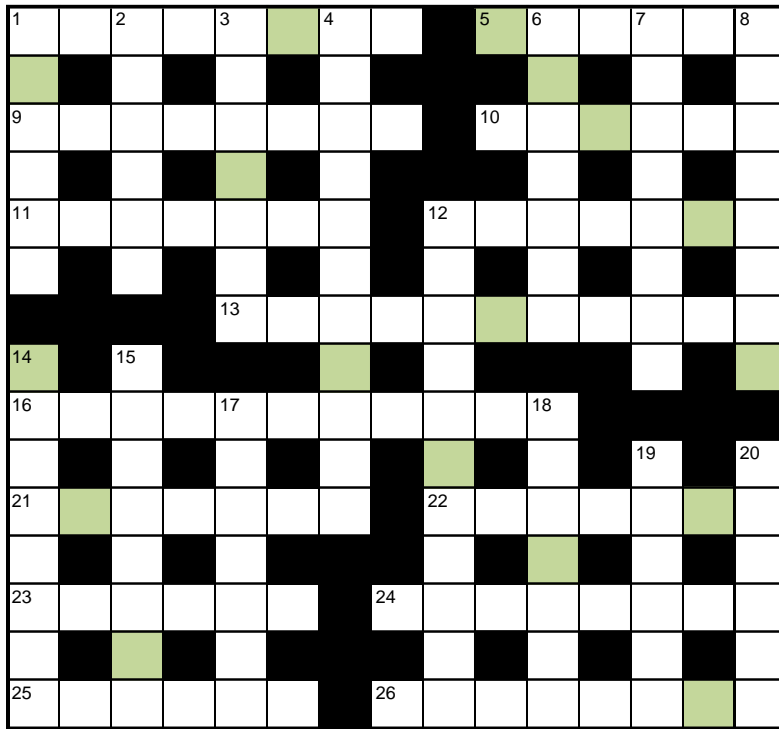


## Branston U3A Crossword 36 – and Polyword
