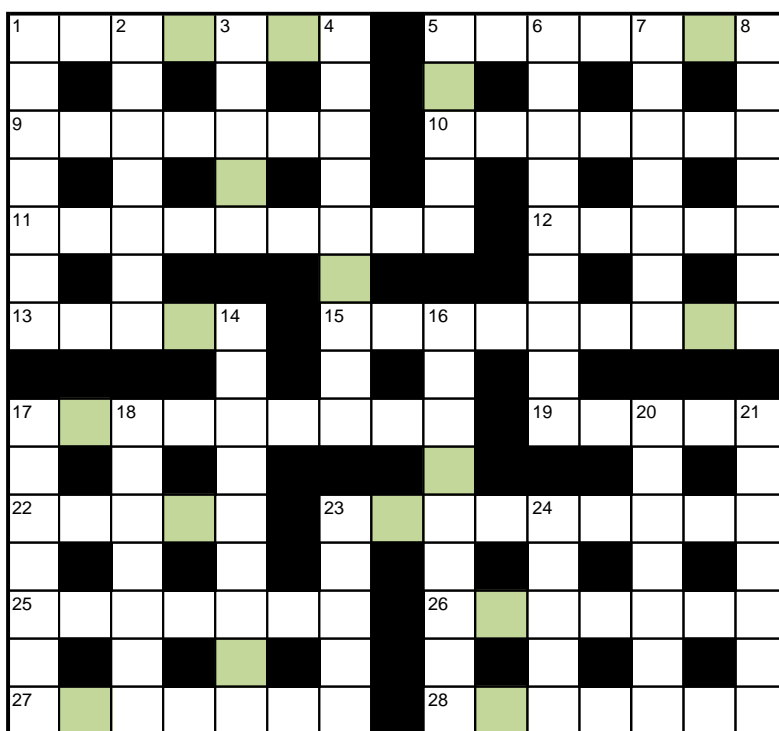


Branston U3A Crossword 39 – and Polyword
