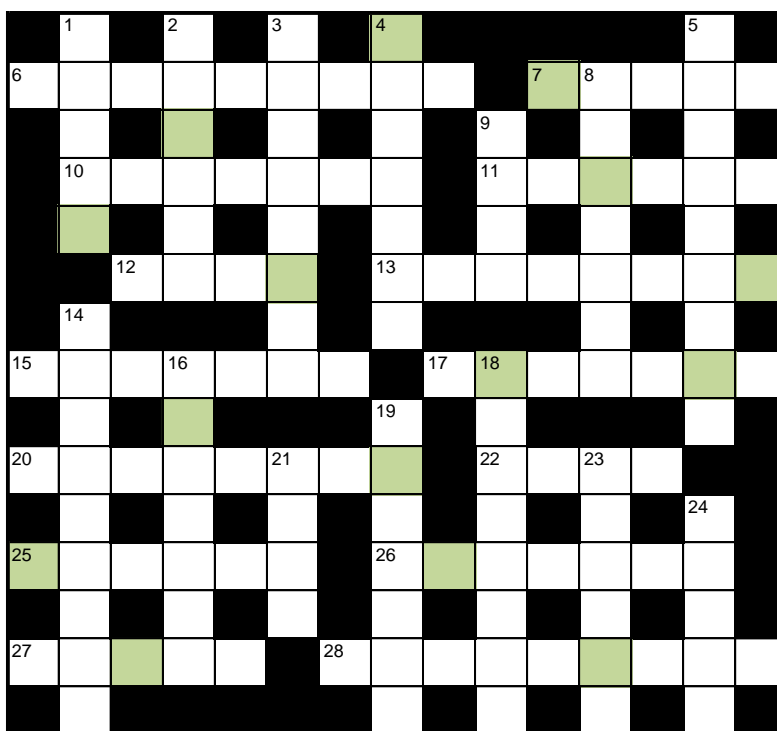


## Branston U3A Crossword 5
