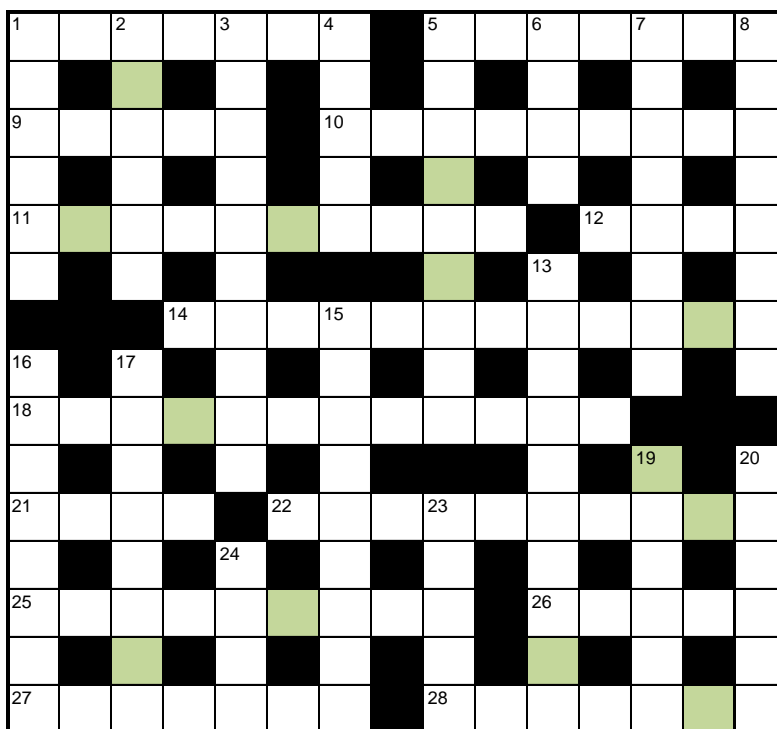


Branston U3A Crossword 12
