It was tricky to poke the holes through the notebook cover: absolute precision was required, otherwise there was the risk that if two holes were punched too close together, it was impossible to make the stitch as the card tore, so the pattern was spoilt! Quite a bit of Sellotape was utilised to repair some errors!

Still, despite everything some beautiful notebooks were sewn using a variety of threads, so as usual, the results were all very different.
