Autumn Wreath with Paper Flowers: October '21

This month, as it was Autumn, the Craft Group decided to embrace it and make some Autumn wreaths. The basic polystyrene ring was wrapped in hessian (a horrible material to work with – very messy!) and then we set about making some thick paper Chrysanthemums as the main 'flowers' on the wreath. This required a lot of fiddly cutting out (9 sets of petals per flower) and a lot of rolling and gluing. Once everyone got the hang of the technique, the tricky Chrysanthemums began to emerge from a sea of cut paper! Some people only had time to make one or two flowers before having to choose their embellishments and stick the whole wreath together with our trusty glue guns. As is always the case, each wreath looked very different depending on the number of flowers made, the colour selection and the choice of embellishments.
