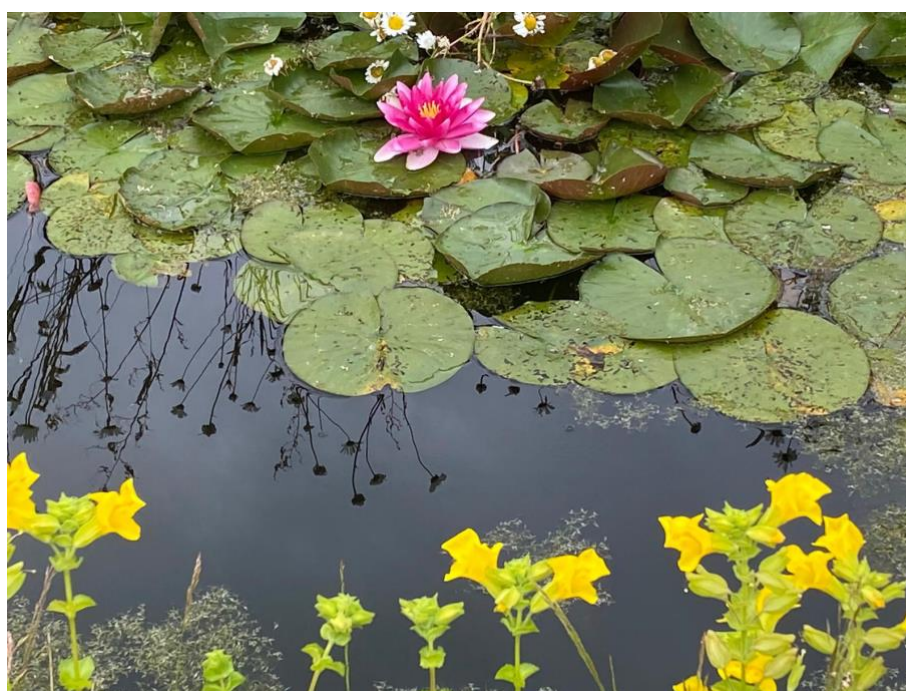

The Manor has a rich history that dates back to the 13th century, the estate is home to 60 colourful gardens, a zoo, and an all-important restaurant.

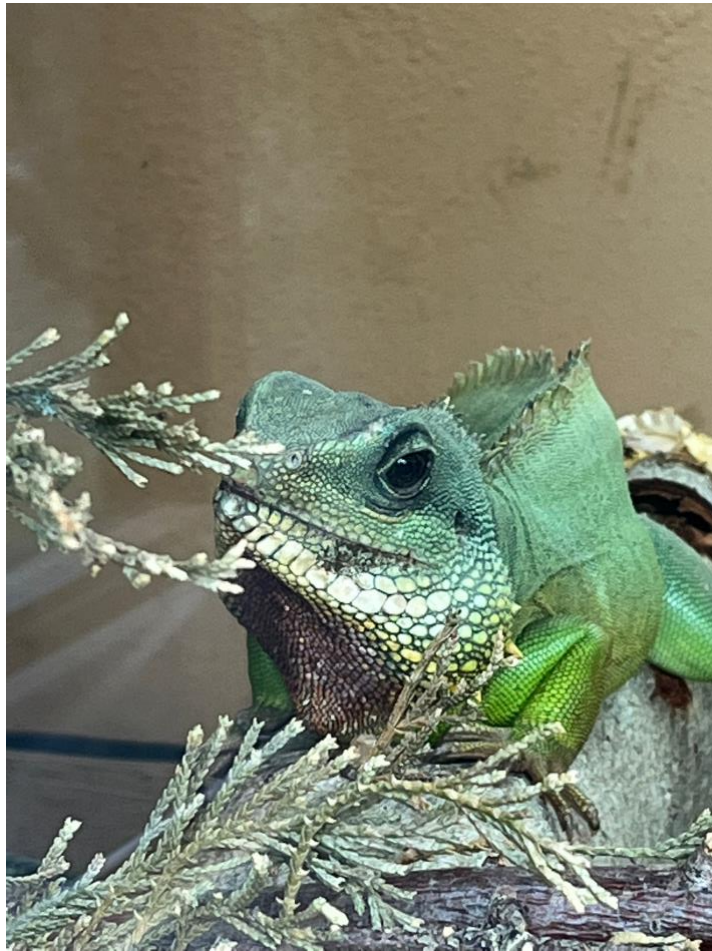
