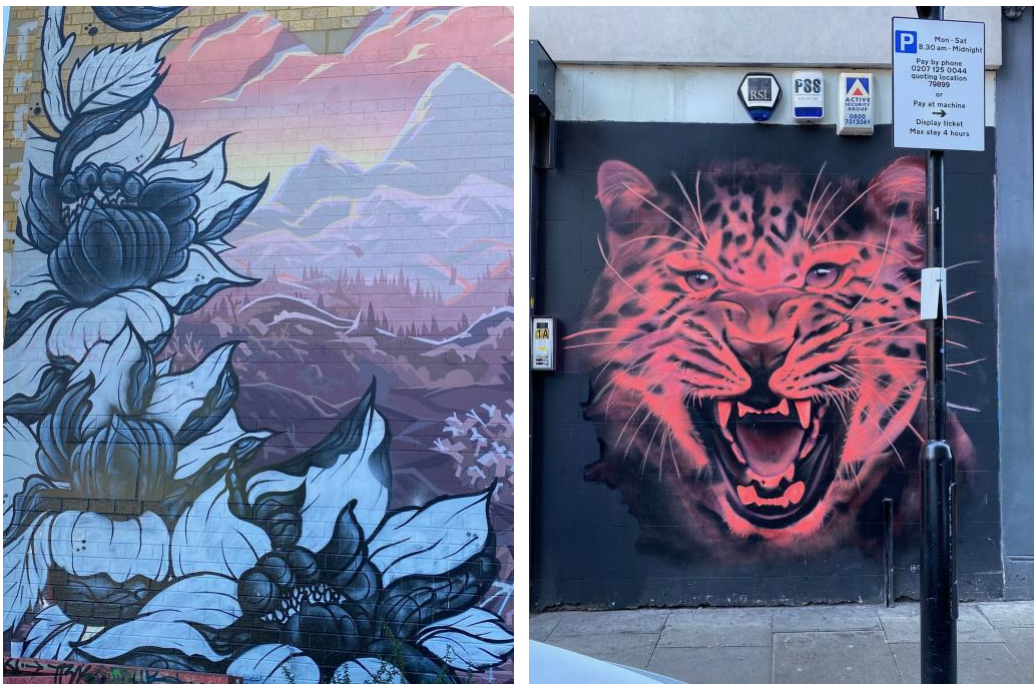


Photography Group

Despite the difficulties of organising the outing we eventually had a successful visit, and some examples of our photographs are included below.



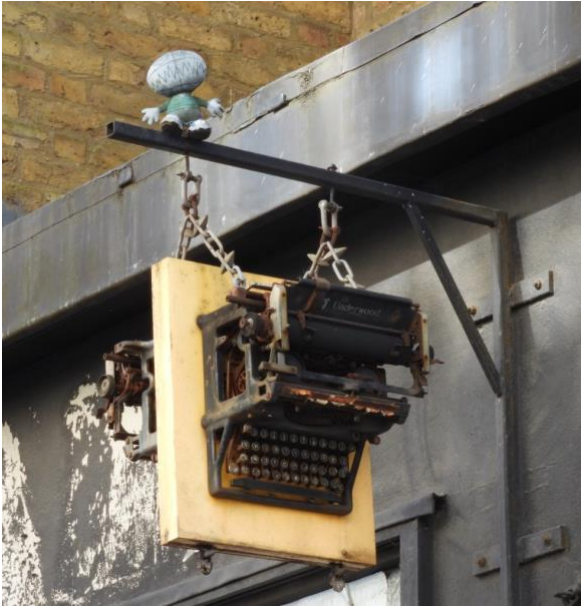
