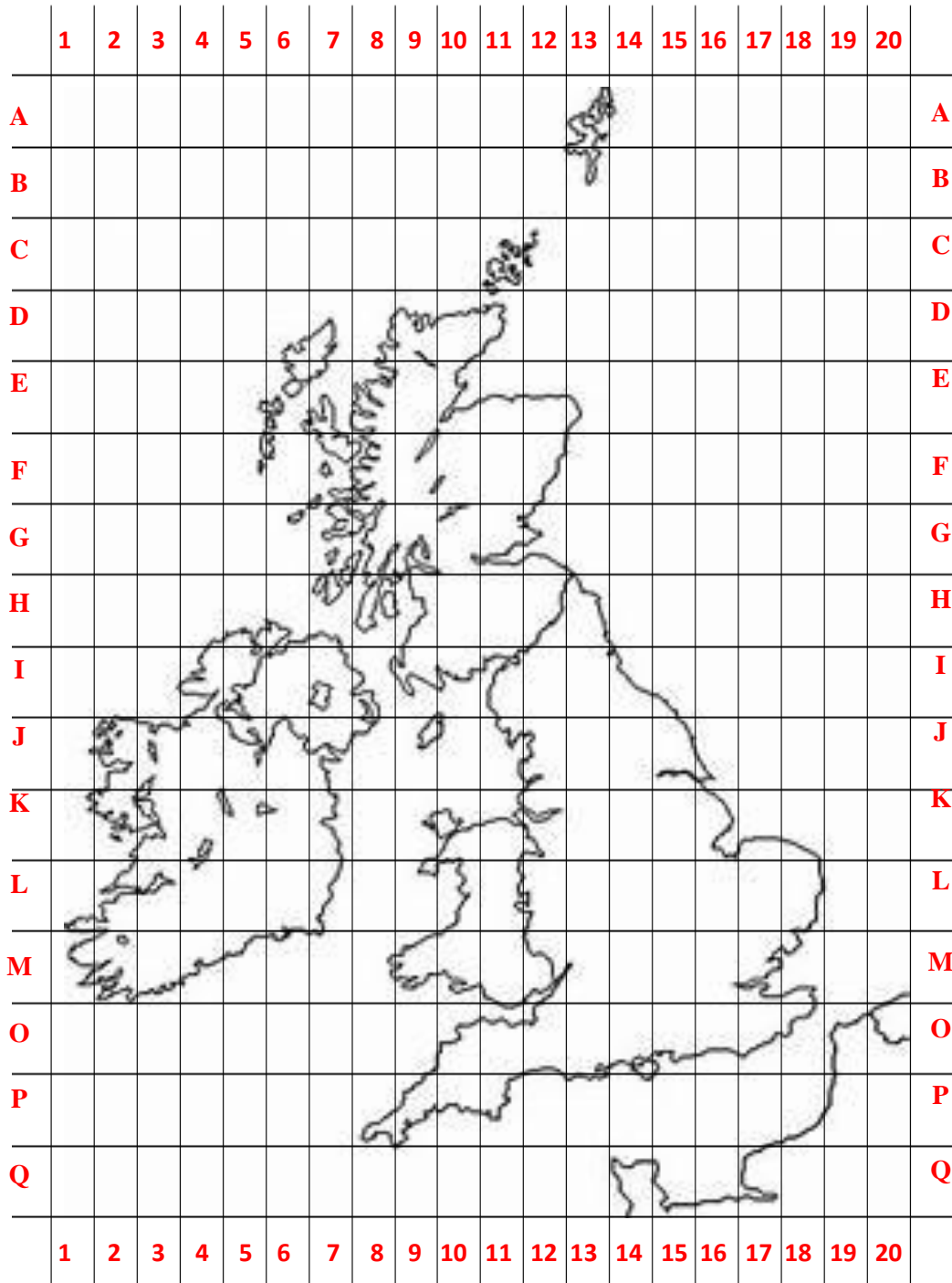


LOCATING LOCATIONS
