Meet 9:30 am in second carpark behind Arden Hall or 10 am in the carpark at Manor Farm Craft Centre, Wood Lane, Earlswood B94 5JH. (Directions: Jnc 4 – M42 – turn right towards Birmingham A34 – first left Creynolds Lane / Vicarage Road / left into Salter Street / Shutt Lane / right Valley Road/ left Wood Lane. Please note that the Manor Farm Centre car park is fee paying (£3 all day) but if you buy something there you will be given a code for the machine which would allow you 4 hours free parking. (There is also a small free car park on the left as you enter Wood Lane).

The walk is approx. 5 miles long with some road walking around the lakes and Wood Lane. Much of the walk is through the woods on suitable paths. We will be crossing the railway twice, once on an up-an-over bridge and the other carefully crossing on a flat surface across the line. Here there is a good visibility both ways and we're told that trains only run once an hour. There is one stile on our way back to the lakes. Toilets are available at the craft centre. You can bring your own packed lunch or after the walk, buy a meal at Manor House Tea Rooms (menu on line) where the most expensive meal is £6.50.


Lunartics

A Thing Called Theia

A Mars-sized planet that struck Earth 4.5 billion years ago and gave birth to the moon, a new study has suggested that there may be remnants of that planet deep inside the Earth. For a long time, there has been agreement that a planet we have called Theia led to the creation of our moon after crashing into the early Earth and smashing off a large section of our planet. This section of the Earth, over a few million years, locked into the Earth's gravity field; coalesced into the globe we now call The Moon.

A new investigation by Geoscientists at Arizona State University has suggested that remnants of the planet that struck the Earth those millions of years ago are still inside our planet beneath West Africa and the Pacific Ocean!

Though you may be interested in seeing what the Sun is doing. This is a photo I took a day or two ago using the 70mm 'scope and Olympus camera. What you see are several Sunspot Groups across the solar disk, the larger ones at least Earth sized. Sunspots are the broken ends of huge magnetic twisted fields breaking through to the 'surface' of the Sun.
