

**Thursday 30th. November**, meet at 9-30am. in second car park behind Arden Hall for car sharing. The walk starts from Bosworth Battle Heritage Centre, Ambion Lane, Sutton Cheney, Nuneaton. CV13 0AD. the ticket machine for the car park is in the first car park on the Right Hand Side as you drive towards the buildings. Parking charge is £2-50 which can only be paid in cash (no change given) or by using the phone AP. displayed at pay point. The walk1- is around 1.5 miles if we just walk round battle field reading the information boards, it takes around one hour. The walk is on a hard surface path, one short area has a bit of surface mud not deep. Walk 1, Would leave plenty of time to look round the museum. There is a charge of £8-50 or £8-0 if your 60 years or older. This ticket can be use again by the named person for more visits for the next 12 months.

**Walk 2** -is around 4.5 miles starting round the Battle Field then short walk along the road to canal, we leave the canal and the route goes via park land fields belonging to the Hall then returning by tow path and rejoining the Battle Field before some more footpaths over fields. On this walk there may be some cattle in fields, plus 2 low stiles, no steep hills and very low levels of mud. Toilets are at start and end of walk and possibly on route as well, picnic benches are available at start or food and drinks in the Tithe Barn or bring your own packed lunch and drinks.

**Thursday 14th. December**, meet at 9-30am. in second car park behind Arden Hall or at start of walk at Dog and Doublet Kingsbury 10am. This easy walk will be no more than 4 miles on good firm paths around the Water Park. Toilets on route and at pub. Risks very low, only trips or falls may be in water and of course crossing roads.


