The Solstices

What are the 'Solstices? Well, we have two a year one in June (we've just had one) and one in December. The word is derived from the Latin 'Sol' (Sun) and 'Sistere' (Standing still). In the northern hemisphere it is when the north pole is tipped as far as it can go towards the sun which is at its maximum height and for a brief period the sun appears to stand still before starting its descent.

The Earth is tilted at 23.5 degrees from the plane of the solar system and as the Earth moves around the sun in its orbit it tilts the (in the Northern Hemisphere) North Pole

towards or away from the sun, hence the seasons. No tilt no seasons! Half way between these positions of course we have the 'Equinoxes where we have twelve hours (about) of equal night and day.
