Hi All, Just fitted a motor drive to the telescope mount that enables the 'scope to follow things in the sky without having to keep twiddling the controls (well mostly). One problem I'm having at present though with the new mount, is re-balancing the 'scope after attaching the camera. Hopefully this will be solved soon and I'm able to show some astropics shortly.

Solar activity – The sun has several active sunspot areas with some quite complex in structure.

May 26 – Moon passes between Jupiter and Venus in the early hours of the morning in the eastern sky.

May 29 – Jupiter and Mars close together in the early eastern sky.

June 7 – First guarter Moon.
