The DIY group was launched in March and our first meeting was held in April. We meet monthly every 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday morning, at my house in Warlingham, in a large 'shed' which resembles a smaller version of the Repair Shop barn!

We started off with about 8 members and the membership has grown steadily and is now 16. We generally get about 8 to 10 people attending meetings, so the group has got off to a good start. There is a mix of novice, improvers and experienced DIYers with a good range of skills.

Our activities are fairly mixed, so there is always a good variety of interest and different aspects of DIY and crafting. Since the launch we have tackled quite a few projects, including:-

- (1) Repairing torn garden cushions
- (2) Modifying, repairing and re-wiring a vintage lamp
- (3) Renovating/re-polishing a table
- (4) Had a demo on tool and chisel sharpening and French polishing
- (5) Made garden obelisks from roofing battens (6 completed over several sessions)
- (6) Had a tutorial and demo of stained glass making and repair
- (7) Discussed home DIY queries, including how to drill into walls/hang shelves/pictures, etc
- (8) Provided basic tuition to beginners on sawing, drilling and screw fixing wood together
