FONDLY REMEMBERED

David Crimlis 1931-2024

David died on 2nd January 2024.

David was born in Hull and worked for Reckitts. He married his first wife Sylvia Mitchell in 1953. They had two children, a boy and a girl. The whole of his life was spent with music. He was a member of many societies as well as being on the committee of Gilberdyke Health Centre, Caves u3a and the organist of Newport Chapel for many years. He married his second wife

Joyce Ballantyne in 1984. He joined Mike Pinfold's u3a Jazz Group to see if he could come to understand it.

David Crimlis was a man of strong opinions. Invariably they were contrary to those of everyone else. Tempered, however, by an endearing sense of humour.

I rarely agreed with his views, if ever, but I liked him a lot and enjoyed his company immensely.

A good pianist, he had a great love of music, classical and spiritual, but admitted that 'jazz' was a blind spot. This irritated him considerably, hence him joining the Caves u3a Jazz Appreciation Group.

On his first visit we happened to play Bert Stern's video "Jazz on a Summer's Day", lasting approximately 2 hours. At the end of the film members expressed their likes and dislikes freely. David remained silent. 'What did you think David?' I asked 'Oh I hated it all' he replied adding 'some parts I hated more than others.'

Nevertheless, he persevered and became a regular and popular group member. His views on jazz barely changed, although he expressed appreciation of the 'stride' pianists. He also liked Art Tatum but couldn't stand Oscar Peterson - 'too busy showing off!!'

I'm sure that now up in heaven, David is already admonishing the Angel Gabriel with regard to the 'heavenly choir' 'They're singing the wrong harmoneys and the contralto on the left is flat'. Go get 'em David. You know you're right.
