Review of GDPR:

No issues arising.

Review of Monthly Attendance:

- Attendance remaining stable at 31% of membership.
- Pre-Covid attendance at monthly meeting ~ 50%.

- Also a reduction in group attendance.

Chairman's Report:

- Coffee morning at Cornerstones in September had only limited success. About 25 people attended with no potential new members coming forward. Costs £85.
- The next one will be in June 2024 and will remain free entry.
- The next coffee morning will have a "focus" and also try to attract new members.
- Succession Planning: 5 key roles identified.
 - o Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership and Speaker Secretaries
- Suggest we try to recruit people to assist in these roles and stand in when necessary.
- Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Policy will be introduced to the Cestria u3a portfolio of procedures. Voted in by 4 votes to 3. TAT policy will be reviewed and sent to committee for discussion and approval.

Treasurer's Report:

- The bank balance belonging to u3a at 4th October is £2,748. Budgeted balance at 31st December is £4276.
- Budget 2024:
 - No increase in membership fees with a membership at about 200.
 - Pro-rata membership fees will be voted on at Feb 2024 A.G.M. i.e. half price from 1st July.
 - Monthly meeting fees will go back to £2.
 - o Room fees increased by 5%.
 - Groups will remain subsidised.
 - Unknown increases are Capitation Fees, Beacon Costs and Magazine Subscription.
 - o Based on current membership a small deficit of ~£300 is predicted.

Secretary's Report:

- A.G.M. documents to go early December.
- Send Nomination Papers to committee immediately.

Group Coordinators Report:

- Continues to attend Group Coordinators Zoom meetings.
- Next group leaders meeting 21st November.
- New display boards purchased.
- Took part in Beacon training.
- Photography group now closed due to lack of members.
- Bridge group of hold until the New Year.

Membership Secretary's Report:

- Currently 204 members.
- 2 on waiting list.
- There have been 21 new members in 2023.
- Welcome team up and running.

Speaker Secretary's Report:

- Meet with AH and MW to start the 2024 list.
- 50% of speakers booked.
- Recommended to contact: The Peoples Kitchen. The Land of Oak and Iron and Beekeepers.

Website Administrator's Report:

- Recommends the move to SiteWorks website platform as the current Site Builder will cease to be supported.
- Terms and conditions for use have not yet been published.
- It's expected there will be a charge for using this platform going forward, but costs will have to be monitored before committing.
- Implementation dates not yet know, but we will be added to a migration schedule when current data will be migrated across to the new system.
- Set up a Sub-Committee or Working party to oversee the project. R.B. has agreed to help.
