## A NOTE FROM THE CHAIR

In August, we were treated to an interesting talk by one of our own at the open meeting. Neil Rutter presented the work done by the LIONS Club International in the UK and globally. I was particularly impressed with their work for eyesight, from the 1925 talk by Helen Keller to the creation of Sight First in the 1990s and their research and support for cases of river blindness, glaucoma and more in Africa. I also got introduced in August to the book "Age Proof" by Professor Rose Anne Kenny, about her research with Trinity College Dublin on the simple changes we can make to live longer, happier, and healthier lives. According to this, about 80% of our ageing biology is within our control. She recommends active lifestyles, social activities, friendship, volunteering, laughing, learning new things, exercise and getting a good night's sleep. Most of these activities can be performed through the u3a.

Finally, a word about the newsletter: we have tried changing the periodicity of Chatterbox over the past few issues but have concluded that it is best if it can be published at the end of the month, as some have found it confusing to have the calendar published a month in advance.
