### **VISIT TO THE JINNEY RING CRAFT CENTRE**



**The Jinney Ring Craft Centre** is located in Hanbury, near Bromsgrove B60 4BT. On site there are a wide range of crafts people working in their own individual businesses as well as a large quirky gift shop and artist gallery, both selling unusual gifts and works of art.

The Craft Centre is set in lovely gardens with duck ponds and wide views across to the Malvern Hills. At the time we are visiting there is a sculpture trail through the gardens. The Farmhouse Restaurant, housed in a genuinely rustic old barn will be a lovely place to have lunch.

### **AND HANBURY HALL**

After lunch you may like to visit Hanbury Hall (National Trust) which is located just a mile away (Sat Nav WR9 7EA).



A country retreat in the heart of Worcestershire. The house and garden, originally a stage-set for summer parties, offer a glimpse into life at the turn of the 18th century. The original formal gardens have been faithfully recreated.
