

# XMAS LIGHT TRAIL AT KEW GARDENS 29th NOVEMBER 2023

After an uneventful journey we arrived at Kew Gardens with the temperature at near freezing, but at least it was dry. This is the tenth anniversary of Kew Gardens winter spectacular. This year they are 21 light installations to see around the three kilometre walk. In addition to some past works such as *Christmas Cathedral* (a tunnel of lights), Kew has eight new light installations including *Spark Ballet and Floating Candles*.
