SCRABBLE GROUP

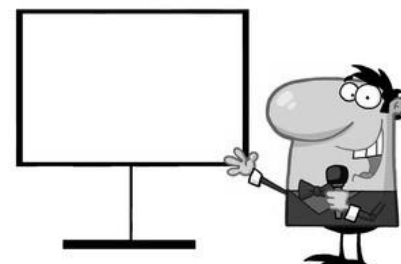
From September we revert to meeting twice monthly, on the 2nd and 4th Friday mornings of the month, from 10am to around 11 30am.
