1) Use infrastructure to unlock net zero

Accelerate the connection of all solar and onshore wind schemes to the national grid
Reform our approach to planning so that solar and onshore wind can be deployed quickly

2) Create sustainable governance structures for net zero

Establish a X-department Office for Net Zero Delivery

3) Back businesses to go green

Review incentives for business investment in decarbonisation
Build skills needed for the transition and support SME's plan and invest in the transition

4) Catalyse local action

Reforming the planning system at local and national level to place net zero at its heart
Back at least one Net Zero City, local authority and community to reach net zero by 2030

5) Increase government transparency

Expand the government's policies and public reporting on net zero
Ramp up public information through a new engagement plan, carbon calculator & eco labelling

6) Deliver cleaner, cheaper, greener homes

No new homes to be built with a gas boiler from 2025
Make heat pumps a widespread technology & legislate to end gas boiler installation by 2033

7) Capitalise on international leadership

Removing trade barriers to environmental goods and services

8) Research

Ramp up R&D investment in green technologies
