Amendment to the Collingham and District U3A Constitution June 2018

Background

An object clause in a constitution states the purpose and range of activities of an organisation. In charities this is the same as the charitable purposes.

The 'object clause' in the Collingham and District U3A original Constitution read:

'to advance education and in particular the education of people not in full time gainful employment who are in their Third Age (being the period of time after the first age of childhood dependence and the second age of full time employment and/or parental responsibility) residing in **Collingham & District.**'

The Third Age Trust recommended the following amendment to the Object Clause.

'The advancement of education and in particular the education of older people and those who are retired from full time work by all means including associated activities conducive to learning and personal development.'

This amendment was proposed and unanimously passed at the Collingham & District U3A AGM in June 2018.
