This will feature many local groups and performers

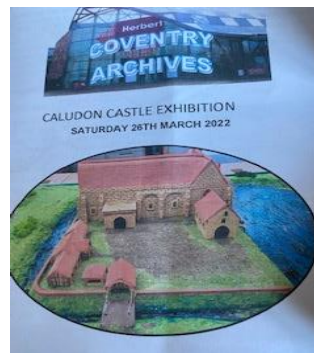
Look out for familiar Faces!!!
