If you need to cancel a booking, we cannot buy your ticket back, but if there is a waiting list the organiser of that outing will try to find a person who can take your place who will then pay you. Any questions regarding a particular outing should be made to the **organiser** of that outing.

If an event has to be cancelled through lack of support or due to poor weather your money will be refunded, less any cancellation charges.

The prices quoted for all outings include the driver's tip, admission charges where appropriate and administration costs. Please be aware that an itinerary might have to be changed on the day, due to unforeseen circumstances.

**ROYAL PAVILION, BRIGHTON  
and PRESTON MANOR**

These contrasting venues illustrate the life-styles from two very different periods of history. First we will drive to Brighton where we should arrive with time to buy coffee before our timed entry to the Royal Pavilion at 11.10 am. The Pavilion is an exotic palace which mixes Regency grandeur with the visual style of India and China. It was built over 200 years ago as a seaside pleasure palace for George IV. On display this year is an exhibition, 'The Regency Wardrobe', which is a collection of imagined garments reflecting the style of the Regency period. Each piece is crafted from just paper and thread. There is a free audio guide which can be accessed through your smartphone. (Remember to bring headphones if you wish to use it.)

For lunch you may choose to visit one of the numerous, nearby restaurants or you might prefer to bring a packed lunch which you can eat in the gardens of the Pavilion.

At 1.45 pm we will board our coach again for the short drive to Preston Manor. This is a charming, historic house, held throughout the centuries by the wealthy and influential. It is now elegantly decorated and furnished in Edwardian style, illustrating the life both upstairs and downstairs of the Stanford family who owned it during that period.

After a look around the gardens and perhaps a cup of tea at the nearby park cafe, we will head for home at approximately 4 pm

**HISTORIC DOCKYARD PORTSMOUTH  
AND A GUIDED TOUR OF THE MARY  
ROSE MUSEUM**

A visit to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard takes you on a journey through time, allowing you to step on board some world-famous ships. The ***Three Attraction Explorer*** ticket will allow you to choose from several possibilities any three attractions of your choice. There is the Mary Rose, Henry V111's legendary warship, HMS Victory best known for her role in the Battle of Trafalgar, HMS Warrior and HMS M.33 as well as three museums. It is probably worth looking on the website before the trip to determine which ones you might like to select. NB The Harbour Tour cannot be included as one of your options.

An hour-long guided tour of the Mary Rose exhibition is included in the price we are paying.

There are numerous cafés and restaurants within the dockyard where a variety of food and drinks can be purchased. The Mary Rose also has a café, as well as Boathouse 4 and Boathouse 7.

Stonor has been used as a location for a number of film and television productions, such as Midsomer Murders and Hornblower, also as a venue for two episodes of BBC's Antiques Roadshow in February 2021.

On the day of our visit we will have free flow access to the house which will be specially decorated for Christmas and the Christmas Fair will be taking place on the front lawn with 100 festive stands and heated marquees.
