

Visits by Out & About Group 6 - 2017/2018

Tangmere Aviation Museum- Excellent value at £6.30. Best visited by car. Request a guide. And allow at least 3 hours to see it all. Of interest to ladies and men. The Naffi cafe does very reasonable snacks and drinks

Harry Potter World. Everyone loved this. It's expensive at £37 but worth it. It's 90 minutes by train, with a shuttle service to the museum. Cafe does sandwiches etc. Allow several hours to see it in full.

Postal Museum. See the full history of the postal service, then travel on an underground mail train beneath the streets of London. £10.60

London Canal Museum. Near Kings Cross station. It's small but very cheap, and very interesting. Afterwards, you can walk along the canal towpath for an hour, taking in all the sights. The museum do a guide to this which is worth getting.

Portsmouth Dockyard. It's £25.20, but that gives you unlimited access to all the attractions, and the ticket is valid for a year. You can also visit Gunwharf Quays and the Spinnaker Tower, and do a boat trip round the harbour

Bolney Wine Estate Tour. An opportunity to see how the wines are made, as well as sample a few. £16

Greenwich Pier Boat Trip. £7.50. As well as a trip down the Thames, you can explore The Pier, and take a stroll down the embankment

Brighton Station Tour. We were a bit disappointed with this. For £8.75 you get to see all the bits the public don't. It needs to be booked during the Brighton Festival

Highgate Cemetery. Visit the tomb of Karl Marx, as well as other things of interest.

The Clink. A chance to enjoy gourmet food served by prisoners. Well recommended.

St Paul's Cathedral/ Fire Fire Exhibition. Learn all about The Great Fire Of London

Christ's Hospital Horsham. A fascinating chance to see a different world. As well as a guided tour, you get food in the canteen, and meet the pupils.

Ford Recycling Centre. See what happens to all our recycling, how it is processed, plus a very interesting talk. Everyone really enjoyed this one. You need a car to get there e
