A wonderful mix of ancient and modern, this one is set in the Norfolk marshes, a delicious combination of abduction, murder, mysticism, archaeology, Nordic legends and neolithic ritual, it is hard to put down. For our meeting in December, we read *Canal Pushers* by Andy Griffe. Another page turner and enjoyed by the majority of the group. It is the first of a trilogy of murder mystery books set along the English canals. Involving an out of work and homeless journalist, a mysterious stranger who understands narrowboats, a cannabis farm and a serial killer (amongst others) this book has many strands which help to maintain the suspense. Over Christmas we are reading *Gentlemen and Players* by Joanne Harris, an altogether darker affair.
