Members homes (1st Mon pm). Two of our group, Wendy and David, spend part of the year in Portugal and for our September tasting we sampled a selection of everyday wines from different regions that they had brought back from a recent visit. Whilst none of these particular wines can be purchased in the UK, the tasting provided an introduction to indigenous grape varieties that we seldom encounter over here. To add a little spice to the evening we were asked to judge the price bracket that each wine belonged to, with a small prize awarded to whoever had the most correct answers.

Following a bold and acidic sparkling Espumante we tasted two Vinho Verde still whites (100% Alvarinho) from the North then two Branco still whites (Malvasia-fina, Encruzado, Bical, Farenao- Pires, Cerceal- Branco and Borrado das Moscas blends) from the Dao region. Two fruity roses (blends of Arogonez, Touriga Nacional, Tinta Caidada) were followed by two full-bodied reds of which the Cancellus Signature 2019 (a blend of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, and Tinta Roriz) was the clear favourite.
