


St Mary's Church Hall Darley Lane DE1 3AX

St Mary's Church Hall is used for our monthly General Meetings. It is just next to St Mary's Church. You can walk from the town centre by using the pedestrian bridge



which crosses over St Alkmund's Way (A601) from Queens St/Kings Street.

By car, it is best accessed via Edward St/Darley Lane if coming from the north. From other directions access is via Handyside St/Darley Lane.

We use the main meeting room, which is accessed via double doors from the foyer. If you arrive late, simply enter through those doors. Someone will be sitting by the door inside the room to take your name etc.

## **Disabled access**

The rooms are all on the ground floor with no steps.

## Parking

Free parking is available at the Church Hall, accessed via Darley Lane. There is usually plenty of space, but Church activities (eg funeral, special mass) may mean it is full. In this case, you should be able to find parking spaces in surrounding streets.
