At our AGM, a new constitution was adopted. This was based on a model constitution developed for u3as in Scotland by the Third Age Trust. We were able to modify it, so that we could, for example, function (for a while) without a Chair. It has – as is required – now been accepted by the Third Age Trust, and by OSCR (Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator). Many thanks to Clive Brown – my predecessor as our Business Secretary – for handling all of this.
