

Honorary Membership

Procedure for bestowal of Honorary Membership of Dundee U3A

1 Definition

Honorary Membership may be bestowed upon a member who has given exceptional service to the U3A. Nominations for Honorary Membership, supported by at least two members, may be submitted to the Committee for its consideration (Constitution 4.3).

2 Entitlements

Honorary Membership shall be for life and no membership subscription shall be payable. An Honorary Member shall be entitled to the same benefits of membership as all other members.

3 Conditions for nominations

Only current or Honorary Members may nominate or support an application.

4 Documents

A nomination form with instructions and suggested criteria will be maintained on the Dundee U3A website. The completed form must be signed by the nominator and two supporters. Unsigned forms will be rejected.

5 Process

Completed nomination forms shall be sent, either by post or scanned/photographed and emailed, to the Chair. Nominations must be received by the Chair no later than the last day of February for discussion at the March Committee meeting.

6 Decision

Discussion of nominations shall be an agenda item at the March Committee meeting. Following discussion a vote shall be taken. If the nomination is declined the nominator will be advised in writing of the reasons/reasoning. If the nomination is agreed both nominator and nominee will be advised in writing. The nominee will be invited to attend the AGM.

7 Presentation

Following all other business of the AGM a presentation of a scroll conferring Honorary Membership shall be presented.
