From the Vice Chair

A report of the AGM was circulated by email but for members without email the summary of outcomes is:

Membership fee for $2023-24 = \pounds 15$ (a rise of $\pounds 2$), Associate member (primarily a member of another $u3a) = \pounds9$;

Members of groups that meet at paid-for venues will pay an accommodation (previously called 'attendance') fee for every date that the group is scheduled to meet, regardless of whether the individual member attends. The fee will be $\pounds 1.50$ per date (up $\pounds 0.50$);

Payment of attendance fees will be paid to the Group Leader (or other designated group member) at the start of every period. 'Period' means month or term (3/4 months). The choice of period is at the discretion of the Group Leaders/groups.

Scottish Dance Group will collect accommodation fees as before – by attendance and on arrival. Last July we introduced Membership renewal using Beacon and this will continue – renewal may be made from early July but you'll be reminded of this at the end of June. The log-in process has been simplified so should not be as finicky as before and you will be provided with full instructions.
