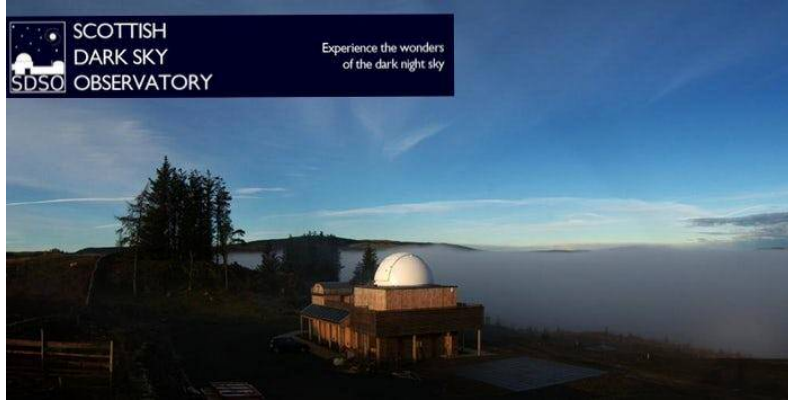


# Scottish Dark Sky Observatory, North Galloway

**Note:** photos are the objects we saw in the telescope but **NOT** the actual telescopic image.

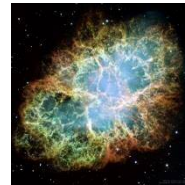
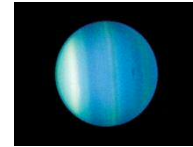
- Planet: Mars in Aries
- Star: Almach in the Andromeda constellation (double star in telescope, actually a multiple star system)
- Cluster: M45 'Pleiades' or 'Seven Sisters' in Taurus
- Star: Sirius in Canis Major
- Cluster: Perseus (a double cluster, often called h & Chi Persei)



# Mon 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019





**Note:** photos are the objects we saw in the telescope but **NOT** the actual telescopic image.

- Galaxy: M31 'Andromeda'
- Planet: Uranus in Aries
- Nebula: M42 'Orion'
- Star: Mu Cephei (Herschel's Garnet Star)
- Nebula: M1 'Crab' in Taurus (a supernova remnant)
- Galaxy: M82 'Cigar' in Ursa Major



## Tue 5<sup>th</sup> March 2019

**Note:** photos are the objects we saw in the telescope

- Cluster: NGC 2264 'Christmas Tree' in Monoceros 
- Star: Castor in Gemini (double star in telescope, actually a multiple star system) 
- Cluster: M35 in Gemini 
- Galaxy: M81 'Bodes Galaxy' in Ursa Major (fuzzy due to weather)
